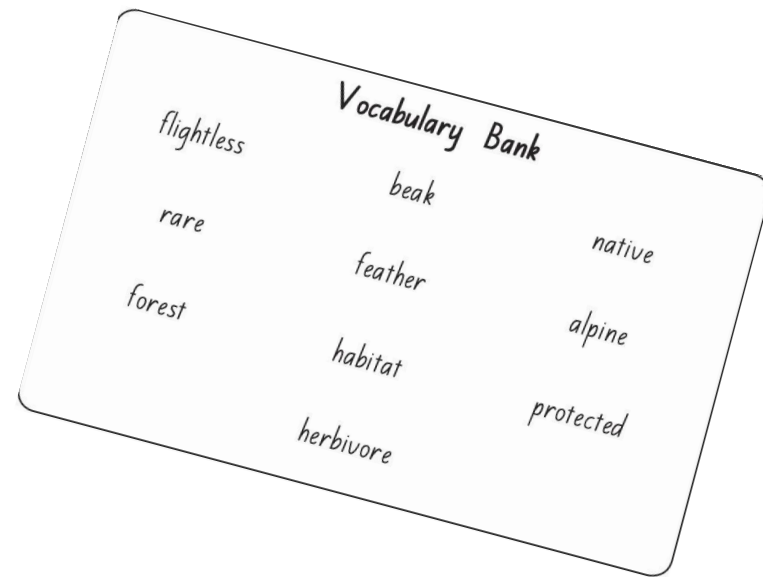




Takahē



A takahe is a **flightless** bird, and is mostly **native** to New Zealand.
